### SmartBanking TIPS



#### Stay Safe When You Go Mobile

We are excited that hundreds of people have downloaded our new mobile APP, MyTSBMobile. We always want to help you protect your identity, so we're sharing these tips from FDIC.gov.

Avoid apps that may contain malware. Buy or download from well-known app stores, such as those established by your phone manufacturer or cellular service provider.

Keep your device's operating system and apps updated. Enable automatic updates, to ensure that you have the latest fixes for any security weaknesses the manufacturer discovers. Says Robert Brown, a senior ombudsman specialist at the FDIC, "Cybercriminals try to take advantage of known flaws, so keeping your software up to date will help reduce your vulnerability to foul play."

Consider using mobile security software and apps to protect your device.

Use a password or other security feature to restrict access in case your device is lost or stolen. Activate the "time out" or "auto lock" feature that secures your mobile device when it is left unused for a certain number of minutes. Doing so reduces the likelihood that a thief will be able to use your phone or tablet.

Back up data on your smartphone or tablet to a computer or a back-up service, which may be offered by your mobile carrier.

Have the ability to remotely remove data from your device if it is lost or stolen. A "remote wipe" protects data from prying eyes. If the device has been backed up, the information can be restored on a replacement device or the original (if you get it back).
